MILITARY SPECIFICATION
MOUNTS, RESILIENT; GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS
AND TESTS FOR (SHIPBOARD APPLICATION)

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-M-17185A(SHIPS), 27 August 1956

Pages 6 and 7, paragraph 4.4.2.2, table I, and paragraphs 4.4.2.3, 4.5.3.2 and 4.5.4: Wherever "Government Inspector" appears, delete and substitute "Inspector"

Page 7, paragraph 4.4.2.3.1: Add "If any sample unit fails in any test, additional units shall be selected and tested in accordance with the column headed 'Second sample quantity' "

Page 12, table V, column 1: Delete "1900 to 2190" and substitute "1900 to 2199".

Page 14: Add the following paragraph:

"4.8 Unless otherwise specified herein the supplier is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements prior to submission for Government inspection and acceptance. Except as otherwise specified, the supplier may utilize his own facilities or any commercial laboratory acceptable to the Government. Inspection records of the examinations and tests shall be kept complete and available to the Government as specified in the contract or order."
