MILITARY SPECIFICATION

MOLDING PLASTIC, POLYAMIDE(NYLON), RIGID

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-M-20693B, dated 10 February 1977, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

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3.1, at end of sentence: Delete "(see 6.2)" and substitute "(see 6.2 and 6.9)."

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Add the following new paragraph:

"6.9 Recovered Monomers - Some polyamides can be depolymerized to their constituent monomer(s), purified and repolymerized. This can be an economical method for reuse of scrap polyamide. Polyamides synthesized from purified, regenerated monomers in this manner shall be considered virgin material to meet the requirements of paragraph 3.1 but recovered material to qualify for consideration under PL 94-580 "Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976" dated 21 October 1976, and OMB Policy Letter No. 77-1 "Procurement of Products That Contain Recycled Material" dated 2 February 1977. When only a fraction of the monomer(s) used to synthesize the polyamide are recovered, the percent of recovered material will be the weight percent of recovered monomer(s) in the polyamide."
