2.2 Other publications, Code of Federal Regulations:

Delete "Transportation, Parts 0-170" and substitute "Transportation, Parts 100-199".

Delete "CFR 0-170" and substitute "CFR 100-199".

5: Delete paragraphs 5.1, 5.1.1, and 5.2 in their entirety and substitute the following:

"5.1 Preservation and packing.

5.1.1 Level A. There is no available Level A pack.

5.1.2 Level B. There is no available Level B pack.

5.1.3 Level C. 1-NITRO-2-PROPANOL shall be packed in accordance with MIL-STD-1190 "MINIMUM GUIDELINES FOR LEVEL C PRESERVATION, PACKING AND MARKING." Containers shall comply with Title 49 CFR parts 100-199, Transportation.

5.2 Marking. Unless otherwise specified the shipping containers shall be marked in accordance with MIL-STD-129, and shall include the batch number. In addition, the following DOT container marking shall be applied to each container:
"Combustible Liquid, nos".
