MILITARY SPECIFICATION  
 POTASSIUM PERCHLORATE

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-P-217A, dated 19 September 1962 and is mandatory for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Paragraph 2.1. Add to Standards: "MIL-STD-1235 - Single and Multilevel Continuous Sampling Procedures and Tables for Inspection by Attributes".

Delete Publications in its entirety.

Paragraph 4.2.2. Delete "Handbook ORD-M608-11" and substitute "MIL-STD-1235".

Paragraph 4.3.5. Delete first sentence and substitute "Dissolve a weighed portion of approximately 5 gms of the sample in approximately 100 mls of hot distilled water".

Paragraph 4.3.6. Delete "Percent potassium chlorate =  $85.50A$  divided by  $W - (1.64B / 0.96C)$ " and substitute - "Percent Potassium Chlorate =  $\frac{85.50A}{W} - (1.64B / 0.96C)$ ."
