

MILITARY SPECIFICATION

PUMPS, CENTRIFUGAL, SEWAGE SERVICE  
FOR USE ON NAVAL SHIPS

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-P-24475(SHIPS), dated 18 December 1972, and is approved for use by the Naval Sea Systems Command, Department of the Navy and is available for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 2

3.1: Delete and substitute:

"3.1 First article. When specified (see 6.1), a sample shall be subjected to first article inspection (see 4.2 and 6.4)."

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4.1. 1(a): Delete "Qualification" and substitute "First article".

4.2: Delete and substitute:

"4.2 First article tests. First article tests shall be performed at a laboratory satisfactory to NAVSEA on each design and size pump. Either horizontal or vertical units may be submitted. Several first article tests on one pump design may be conducted concurrently, if practicable. The tests shall establish that the product has the reliability and performance capability specified herein. The following tests shall be performed:

(a) The performance evaluation tests specified-in 4.3.2 through 4.3.2.3.

(b) The design evaluation tests specified in 4.3.3 through 4.3.3.4."

4.2.1: Delete.

Footnote 1/ at bottom of page: Delete.

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6.1: Add \*(x) First article inspection, if required (see 3.1)."

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6.4: Delete and substitute:

"6.4 First article inspection. Invitations for bids should provide that the Government reserves the right to waive the requirement for samples for first article inspection as to those bidders offering a product which has been previously acquired or tested by the Government, and that bidders offering such products, who wish to rely on such production or test, must furnish evidence with the bid that prior Government approval is presently appropriate for the pending contract.'"
