MILITARY SPECIFICATION

PARACHUTE RECOVERY SYSTEMS, MISSILE AND DRONE, GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-P-25062B, dated 25 September 1964, and is mandatory for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 1, paragraph 2.1: Under Military Standards, add "MIL-STD-849 Inspection Requirements, Definitions and Classification of Defects for Parachutes"

Page 2, paragraph 3.4.1: Delete the last sentence.

page 6, paragraph 3.5: Add at end of paragraph: "(Permissible damage to be specified in the missile and drone system specification.)"

page 6: Add:

"3.5.1 Reliability. unless otherwise specified by the procuring activity, the demonstrated reliability of the recovery system under the design conditions shall be a minimum of 90 percent with a 90 percent confidence coefficient. Tests specified in 4.3.2 shall be of sufficient number to demonstrate the reliability required."

Page 7, paragraph 3.6.3.1, line 10: Delete "ground impact" and substitute "ground or water impact".

Page 10, paragraph 4.1: Delete the second sentence and substitute: "Except as otherwise specified in the contract or order, the supplier may use his own or any other facilities suitable for the performance of the inspection requirements specified herein, unless disapproved by the Government."

page 10, paragraph 4.2, line 3: Delete "acceptance tests" and substitute "quality conformance tests."

page 10, paragraph 4.3: Delete "acceptance tests" and substitute "quality conformance tests."

Page 10, paragraph 4.5.2.1: Delete the first sentence and substitute: "The individual parachutes used in the recovery systems shall be visually inspected in accordance with MIL-STD-849 and for compliance with the fabrication requirements specified herein."
