MILITARY SPECIFICATION

PAD, SANITARY, HEAVY

This Amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-P-36863, dated 7 July 1972, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 2:

3.1.1 Add the following at the end of paragraph: "The absorbent particulate fluff may be contained in a lateral wrap of a continuous absorbent cellulosic tissue sheet, suitable for the purpose, to prevent the fluff from transferring through a foraminous covering."

Page 3:

3.2 Sixth line. Delete "7.00" and substitute "6.75".

Page 7:

5.1.3.2 Intermediate package. Delete entirely and substitute:

"5.1.3.2 Intermediate package. Intermediate package shall be a box of appropriate size and design constructed in accordance with PPP-B-636, type CF, class domestic. Closure shall be adequate to prevent accidental opening under normal handling."

Following paragraph 5.2.1.1 insert new paragraph as follows:

"5.2.1.2 Case liner. Each Level A wood box shall be lined with a waterproof case liner conforming to MIL-L-10547. Closure and sealing shall conform to applicable paragraphs of appendix thereto. Case liner shall not be required for fiberboard boxes. Fiberboard box shall be waterproof in accordance with paragraph 30.4 of PPP-B-636."
