MILITARY SPECIFICATION
PROJECTILE, CALIBERS .22, .30, .50 and 20MM
FRAGMENT - SIMULATING

This Amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-P-46593A (Ord),
12 October 1962.

Specification number: Delete "(Ord)" and substitute "(MU)".

Paragraph 1.2: Delete "2M - (See fig. 4)" and substitute:

"20MM - (See fig. 4)".

Paragraph 4.2.3.2: Delete entire paragraph and substitute the following:

"4.2.3.2 Hardness."

"4.2.3.2.1 Caliber .22 Type 1, Calibers .30, .50 and 20MM fragment-simulating projectiles shall be one hundred percent tested for hardness for compliance with 3.2. All non-conforming material shall be rejected."

"4.2.3.2.2 Caliber .22 Type 2 fragment-simulating projectiles shall be tested for hardness for compliance with 3.2 in accordance with MIL-STD-105. The acceptable quality level (AQL) shall be 2.5 percent defect per hundred. All non-conforming material shall be rejected."

Add paragraph 5.3.1:

"5.3.1 Packing identification. Fragment-simulating projectiles shall be packed separately according to caliber and hardness value."
