"A 569 - Steel, Carbon (0.15 Maximum, Percent). Hot-Rolled Sheet and Strip, Commercial Quality."

3.2, delete in its entirety and substitute:

"3.2 Material. Material for the corrugated steel sheets shall conform to ASTM A 366 (see 6.5)."

Table I, number 101, line 1; delete "Either" and "or condition".

PAGE 6

6.2, line 5; delete "(c) Whether hot-rolled or cold-rolled (see 3.2)".

PAGE 7

6.4, line 5; delete "painted" and substitute "finish".

6.4, line 6; delete "(when applicable)".

6.4, line 8; delete "P" and substitute "X".

6.4, line 14; delete "Painted (when applicable)" and substitute "Finish (see 6.4.5)".

6.4, line 15; after "M11207AABB" add "U".
