Under Federal Specifications delete "LLL-R-626-- Rosin, Gum, Rosin, Wood, and Rosin, Tall Oil".

Under Military Specifications delete "MIL-A-6091--Alcohol Ethyl, Specially Denatured, Aircraft", and "MIL-E-463 Ethyl Alcohol (For Ordnance Use)".

- 3.1.2 Delete entire paragraph and substitute "Flux". A separate flux conforming to MIL-F-14256, Type RMA, shall be used with type S solder.

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- 3.1.4 Delete entire paragraph.
3.2.3 Line 1: after "silver" place "or gold".

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- 4.3.4 Delete "Defect No. 206, Incorrect Inspection Dot".
