MILITARY SPECIFICATION

SPRINGS; HELICAL, AIRCRAFT

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-S-6715, dated 12 June 1950, and has been approved by the Department of Defense for use of the Departments of the Army, the Navy and the Air Force.

Page 1, paragraph 2.1.1 Specifications:

(a) Under "Federal" add the following specification:

"PPP-B-601 Boxes, Wood, Cleated-Plywood"

(b) Under "Military" delete references to Specifications "JAN-STD-105," "JAN-P-105," and "JAN-P-130," and substitute the following:

"JAN-P-120 Packaging and Packing for Overseas Shipment - Cartons, Folding, Paperboard"

(c) Add the following:

"2.1.3 Standards.

MIL-STD-105 Sampling Procedures and
 Tables for Inspection by
 Attributes"

Page 3, paragraph 3.3 Maximum Allowable Working Stress: Delete the paragraph in its entirety.

Page 4, FIGURE 1: Delete figure 1 in its entirety.

Page 5, paragraph 3.13 Cleaning: In the first line delete "passivated" and substitute "cleaned."

Page 6, paragraph 4.2.2 Sampling for Workmanship and Drawing Conformance: Delete the paragraph in its entirety and substitute the following:

"4.2.2 Sampling for Workmanship and Drawing Conformance. Samples shall be selected at random in accordance with Standard MIL-STD-105 Sampling Procedures and Tables for Inspection by Attributes."

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AMENDMENT - 2

Page 7, paragraph 4.3.2.5: Add paragraph title "Decarburization."

Page 7, paragraph 5.3 Packaging: Delete "JAN-P-130" and substitute "JAN-P-120."

Page 8, paragraph 5.4.2 Overseas Packing: Delete first sentence and substitute the following:

"Unless otherwise specified, the packages shall be packed in cleated plywood, or nailed wood boxes and conforming to Specification PPP-B-601 or JAN-P-106, respectively."
