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- * 2.1.1, under "SPECIFICATIONS FEDERAL": Delete the following:
"CCC-C-419 - Cloth, Duck, Cotton; Fire, Water, Weather and Mildew and
Numbered
CCC-C-428 - Cloth, Duck, Cotton; Fire, Water, Weather and Mildew
Resistant"
- * 2.1.1, under "SPECIFICATIONS MILITARY": Add the following:
"MIL-C-43285 - Cloth, Coated (Chloroprene Base Coated, Chlorosulphorated
Polyethylene Top Coated)
MIL-C-44103 - Cloth, Duck, Polyester, Fire, Water and Weather
Resistant"
- * 2.1.1, under "SPECIFICATIONS MILITARY": Delete the following:
"MIL-W-44049 - Webbing, Textile and Tape, Textile Polypropylene, General
Purpose, Natural or in Colors"
- * 2.1.1, under "DRAWINGS": Add the following:
"5-4-6722 - Window, Details and Assembly
5-4-6723 - Screen Window
5-4-6725 - Window"

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3.2.1: Delete and substitute:

"3.2.1 Cloth, polyester, duck. The cloth for the tent, except for the ground cloth and interior reinforcements, shall conform to MIL-C-44103. The color of the cloth shall be Camouflage Green Shade 483."

* 3.2.1.1 Delete and substitute:

"3.2.1.1 Cloth, coated. The cloth for the ground cloth shall conform to type I, class 3 of MIL-C-43285. The color of the cloth (face and back) shall be Camouflage Green Shade 483."

Add the following new paragraph:

* "3.2.1.2 Cloth, duck, cotton. The cloth for interior reinforcements shall conform to MIL-C-43627. The color of the cloth shall be Olive Drab 7."

3.2.2: Delete the last sentence.
