MILITARY SPECIFICATION
 TREATMENT, MOISTURE AND FUNGUS-RESISTANT,
 OF COMMUNICATIONS, ELECTRONIC,
 AND ASSOCIATED ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-T-152B, 31 March 1961, and is mandatory for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 1, paragraph 2.1

SPECIFICATION

MILITARY - add

MIL-I-46058, "Insulating Compound, Electrical (For Coating Printed Circuit Assemblies)."

Page 1, paragraph 3.1 - At end of paragraph add sentence, "The statement of treatment is not required when Specification MIL-I-46058 is specified." (See 3.3.2 (b) 18)".

Page 2, paragraph 3.3.2 (b) 16 - Delete in its entirety and substitute, "Plastic materials of the following types: polyacetal, polyamide, polycarbonate, polyethylene, polypropylene, polystyrene, acrylic, silicone, epoxy, melamine-fiberglass, fluorocarbon, vinyl, and alkyd."

Page 3, paragraph 3.3.2 (b) add: "18. Printed Circuit Assemblies, treated with coating conforming to Specification MIL-I-46058, or other coating approved by the Procuring Activity. The items specified in paragraph 3.3.2 shall be protected against the application of MIL-I-46058, or other approved printed circuit coating."

Page 3, paragraph 3.3.3.2 type II - limited treatment: In last sentence delete "3.3.3.2.1 and," add "Unless specified otherwise, soldered connections shall be treated in accordance with paragraph 3.3.3.2.1."

Page 7, paragraph 6.3, add to (k) and (l) "(fungus-resistant grade only)
 add: (q) Polyacetal - (fungus-resistant grade only)
 (r) Polycarbonate
 (s) Polypropylene"
