This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-T-43036B, dated 9 January 1981, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 1

1.2, Classification.

Type II: Delete "Non-reinforced polypropylene film" and substitute "Non-reinforced polyester film".

Delete "NOTE: Type II may be used in place of Type I tape."

PAGE 3

3.1.2, Line 2: Delete "polypropylene" and substitute "polyester".

PAGE 4

3.5, Holding power. After "a 1000 gram load", add "at 23°C and also a 100 gram load at 68.3°C".

PAGE 5

Table I, Type II:

Tensile breaking strength:

Machine direction: Change "25" to "15".

Cross direction: Change "40" to "20".

Elongation: Change "120" to "100".

Water vapor transmission: Change "1.0" to "2.0".

Water penetration rate: Change "0.50" to "1.0".
