PAGE 6

- \* 4.2: Delete in its entirety.

PAGE 7

Table II, last defect: Delete and substitute "Not material specified".

PAGE 8

4.3.5.1, line 3 after "closure": Insert ", waterproofing".

\* 5.1.2, last sentence: Delete and substitute "The package and quantity per package shall be the same as that normally used by the contractor in retail distribution."

\* 5.2.1, at end of the paragraph: Add "Each shipping container shall be closed in accordance with method III, waterproofed in accordance with method V and reinforced as specified in the appendix of the container specification."

PAGE 10

\* After first sentence: Insert "The quantity per shipping container shall be the same as that normally used by the contractor for retail distribution."

6.2, subparagraph (f): Delete "V3c or V3s" and substitute "grade".

\* 6.2: Delete subparagraph "(c)" in its entirety.

\* 6.3: Delete in its entirety.
