MILITARY SPECIFICATION

WOOD PRESERVATIVE: TETRACHLOROPHENOL AND
 PENTACHLOROPHENOL, SURFACE SEALING COMPOUND

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-W-13518C, dated 11 July 1967, and is mandatory for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

Page 1

2.1: Add after list of Federal specifications:

"Military
 MIL-T-704 - Treatment and Painting of Materiel."

Page 3

3.8: Add after signal word "WARNING": "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN".

3.8: Before "Fire Hazard" add: "Type I - Tetrachlorophenol and Type II- Pentachlorophenol wood preservatives shall inhibit the attack of insects and fungi and shall control oxidation and moisture damage by surface sealing."

3.8: At end of "Application" paragraph add: "Preservative shall be applied in accordance with MIL-T-704."

3.8: After "Application" paragraph add the following:

Active ingredients:	Percent
-----	-----

Inert ingredients -----	-----
Total-----	<u>100</u>

Note: Each ingredient requires the listing on the container of its precise chemical name. Example: 'Alkyl resin solid' should be 'phthalic glyceride' or applicable chemical name."

Page 9

Add the following new paragraph: "6.1.5 Wood preservatives tetrachlorophenol and pentachlorophenol, shall be used to inhibit insect and fungus attack, and to seal the surfaces to reduce deterioration resulting from air, moisture, and the elements."
