MILITARY SPECIFICATION

WINDSHIELD SYSTEMS, FIXED WING AIRCRAFT
GENERAL SPECIFICATION FOR

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-W-81752(AS), dated 27 February 1987, and has been approved by the Naval Air Systems Command, Department of the Navy and is available for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

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3.1.2, delete and substitute:

"3.1.2 WINDSHIELD The windshield shall be designed to provide clear vision for the pilot and to protect the cockpit and crew as defined both in this specification and the airplane detail specification. For tandem cockpit arrangements, when the canopy is jettisoned, wind blast protection shall be provided for each occupant. For single piece windshield/canopy designs, for which primary ingress/egress is via the cockpit transparencies sufficient windblast protection shall be provided for the crew to safely return the aircraft in the advent of the loss of the transparency."
