TRUCKLOADING OF AMMUNITION AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

To: All holders of MIL-STD-1320C(NAVY)

Make the following pen and ink changes:

- a. Para 3.25. Change the definition of stack to read-
"Stack. Two or more layers of containers, unit loads,
or associated items extending widthwise of the vehicle
and one unit in length."
- b. Para 5.2.2. Change note (c) to read - "The length of
the trailer (40, 42, 44, 45, or 48 feet). Where a dash
number sheet specifies a certain length trailer, longer
trailers (not exceeding 48 feet) may be substituted."
- c. Para 5.7.2.1. Change the last sentence to read - "A
minimum of two straps per stack, layer, unit load, or
single container load shall be used."
- d. Para 5.8.1. Change the fourth sentence to read - "A
minimum of two chains and load binders shall be used
for each stack, layer, unit load, or single container
load."
- e. Para 5.10.6. Change to read - "Explosives (other than
blackpowder) and such inert items that might appear to
be explosive in nature to the public may only be
transported on flatbed trailers if fire resistant and
waterproof tarpaulins completely conceal the lading.
This includes containerized items."
- f. Para 5.10.7. Change the fourth sentence to read -
"Each stack, layer, unit load, or single container load
shall have a minimum of two tiedowns."
