

- MATERIAL.** ALUMINUM ALLOY 5086, (UNS A95086), AS SPECIFIED IN QQ-A-200/5.
- FORMING PROCESS.** ROLLED - CODE "R"  
DRAWN - CODE "D"  
COLD FINISHED - CODE "C"  
EXTRUDED - CODE "E"
- PART NUMBER.** THE PART NUMBER CONSISTS OF THE BASIC MS NUMBER, PLUS A FORMING PROCESS CODE, PLUS A DASH NUMBER FROM TABLE I.

- MARKING.** ALUMINUM AND ALUMINUM ALLOYS SHALL BE MARKED WITH THE PRODUCER'S NAME OR REGISTERED TRADE MARK, THE PART NUMBER (MILITARY STANDARD (MS) NUMBER PLUS THE APPLICABLE DASH NUMBER), AND THE LOT NUMBER AND THIS MARKING SHALL BE APPLIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH FED-STD-184.

NOTES:

- ALL DIMENSIONS ARE IN INCHES.
- STANDARD LENGTH OF ROD IS 10 FEET MINIMUM, 12 FEET MAXIMUM.
- REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE OF THE ISSUE IN EFFECT ON DATE OF INVITATIONS FOR BIDS, OR REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL, EXCEPT THE REFERENCED ADOPTED INDUSTRY DOCUMENTS SHALL GIVE THE DATE OF THE ISSUE ADOPTED.
