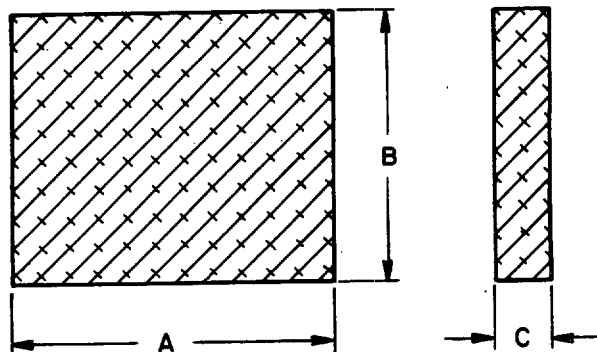


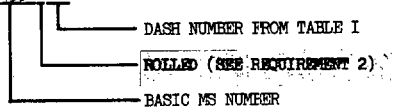

REQUIREMENTS:

1. MATERIAL. ALUMINUM ALLOY 6061, (UNS A96061) AS SPECIFIED IN QQ-A-250/11.
2. FORMING PROCESS. ROLLED (CODE R).
3. PART NUMBER. THE PART NUMBER CONSISTS OF THE BASIC MS NUMBER, PLUS A FORMING PROCESS CODE, PLUS A DASH NUMBER FROM TABLE I.

4. MARKING. ALUMINUM AND ALUMINUM ALLOYS SHALL BE MARKED IN ACCORDANCE WITH FED-STD-184 WITH THE EXCEPTION THAT A PART NUMBER FROM THIS MILITARY STANDARD SHALL BE INCLUDED AS PART OF THE IDENTIFICATION MARKING.

NOTES:

1. ALL DIMENSIONS ARE IN INCHES.
2. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE OF THE ISSUE IN EFFECT ON DATE OF INVITATION FOR BIDS, OR REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL, EXCEPT THE REFERENCED ADOPTED INDUSTRY DOCUMENTS SHALL GIVE THE DATE OF THE ISSUE ADOPTED.
