## REQUIREMENTS:

1. MATERIAL. COMMERCIALLY PURE TITANIUM (CP-1), AS SPECIFIED IN THE PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION.
2. MATERIAL CONDITION. MATERIAL SHALL BE ANNEALED AS SPECIFIED IN THE PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION.
3. FABRICATION METHOD AND FINISH. NUMBER 1 FINISH (HOT-ROLLED, ANNEALED, AND DESCALED) AS SPECIFIED IN THE PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION.
4. LENGTH. STANDARD LENGTH OF TITANIUM PLATE IS 8 FEET NOMINAL.
5. PART NUMBER. THE PART NUMBER CONSISTS OF THE BASIC MS NUMBER, FOLLOWED BY A DASH NUMBER FROM TABLE I.
