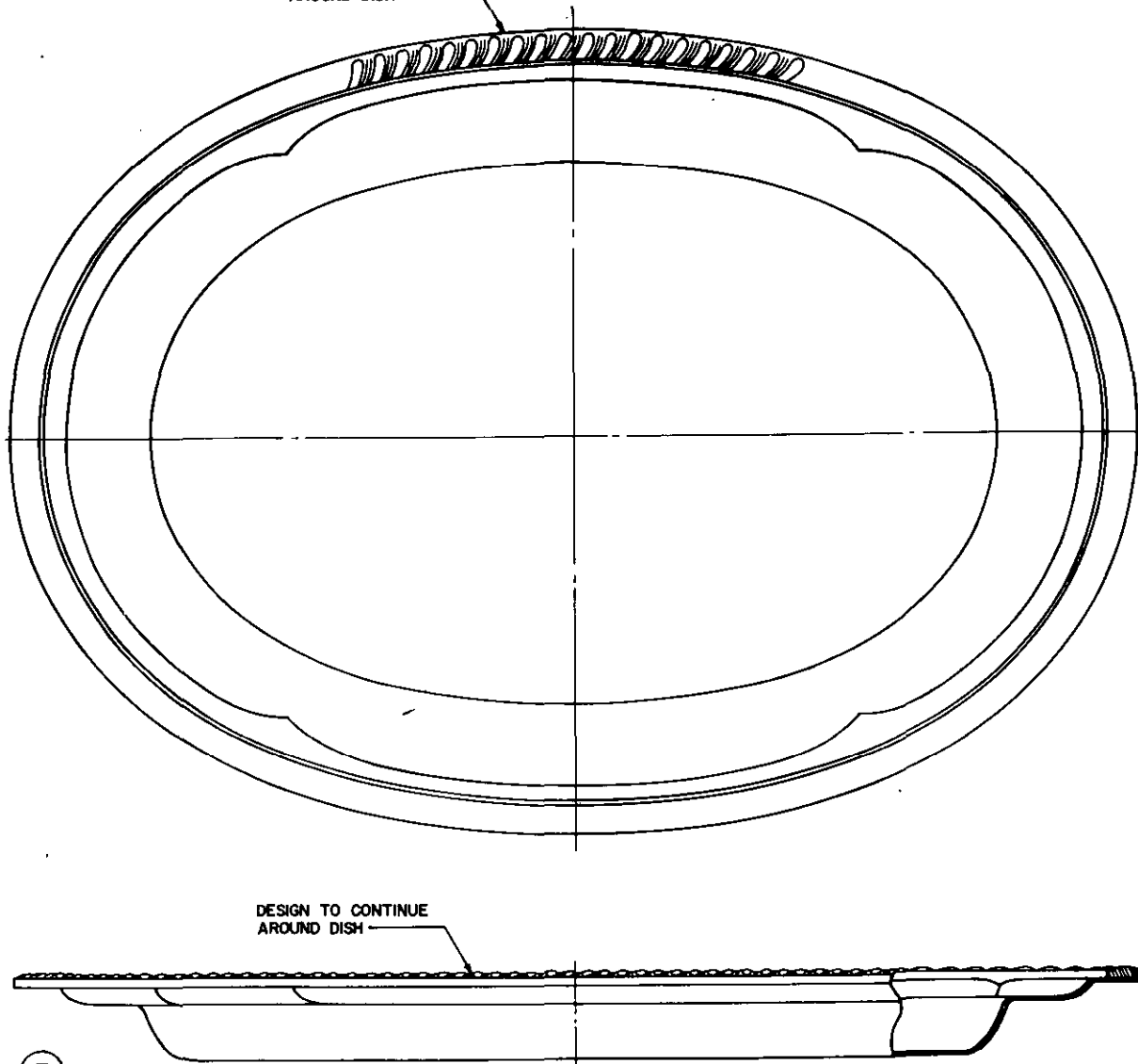

AROUND DISH

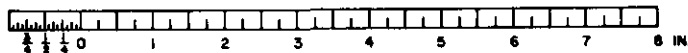
