



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GLASS BODY

NOTES

- Ⓐ 1. SHAKER TOP SHALL BE EITHER NICKEL - BRASS OR WHITE METAL (BRITANNIA) SILVER PLATED WITH A MINIMUM OF 1 TROY OUNCE PER SQUARE FOOT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPECIFICATION RR-T-51
- Ⓑ 2. GLASS BODY SHALL CONFORM TO SPECIFICATION MIL-T-2870, TYPE IV.
- 3. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE OF THE ISSUE IN EFFECT ON DATE OF INVITATIONS FOR BIDS.
- 4. FOR DESIGN FEATURE PURPOSES, THE STANDARD TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER PROCUREMENT DOCUMENTS REFERENCED HEREIN.
