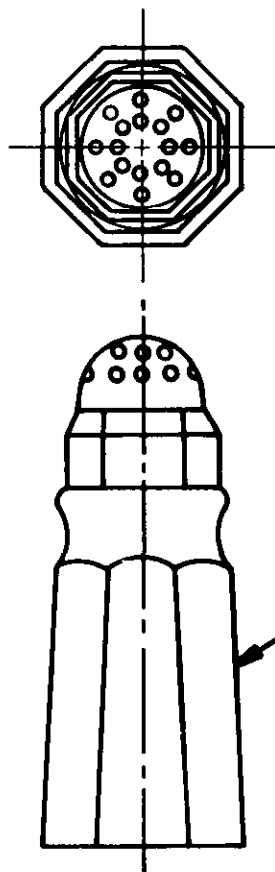

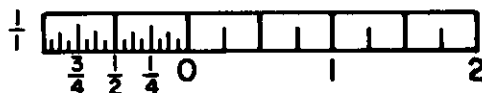

- ② 1. SHAKER TOP SHALL BE EITHER NICKEL - BRASS OR WHITE METAL (BRITANNIA) SILVER PLATED WITH A MINIMUM OF 1 TROY OUNCE PER SQUARE FOOT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SPECIFICATION RR-T-51
- ② 2. GLASS BODY SHALL CONFORM TO SPECIFICATION MIL-T-2870, TYPE IV.
3. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE OF THE ISSUE IN EFFECT ON DATE OF INVITATIONS FOR BIDS.
4. FOR DESIGN FEATURE PURPOSES, THE STANDARD TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER PROCUREMENT DOCUMENTS REFERENCED HEREIN.
