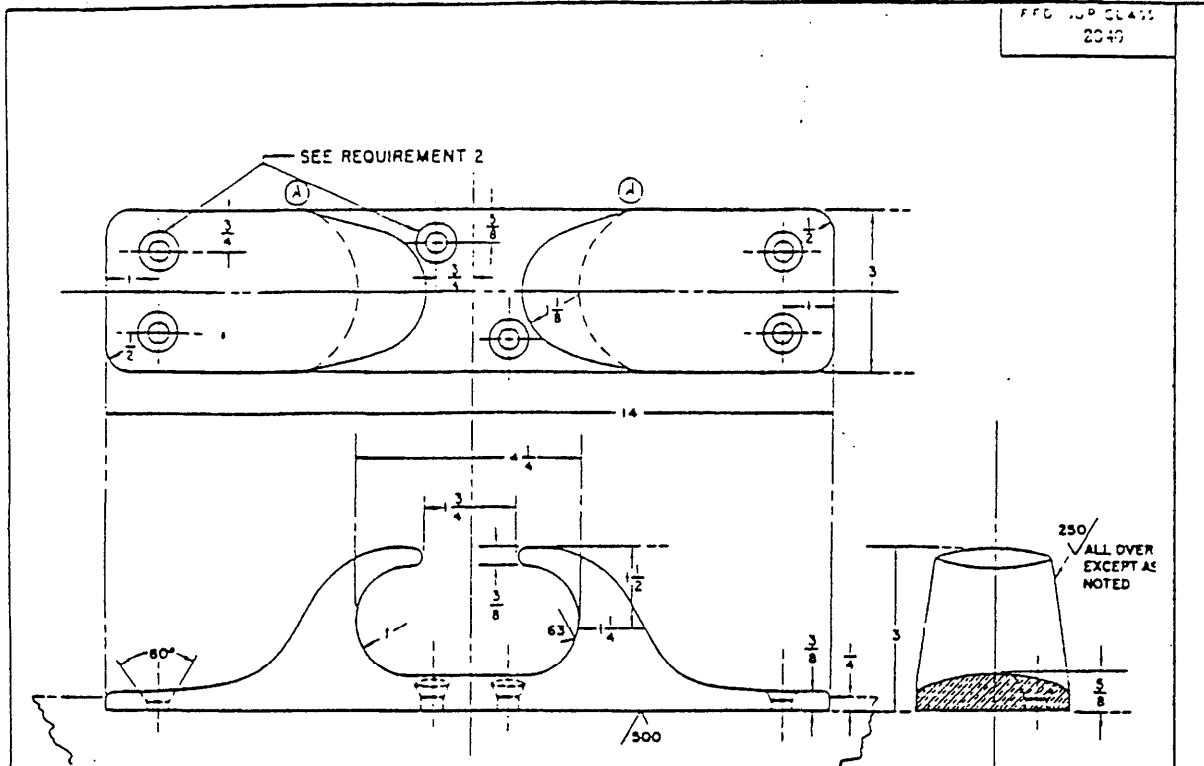

REQUIREMENTS

- ① 1. Check shall be commercial bronze of tensile strength of not less than 20,000 p. s. i.
2. Holes 13/32 inch diameter countersink to suit 3/8 inch diameter flat head machine screws.
3. The allowable tolerances shall be plus or minus 1/8 inch.
4. Used on weather deck of boats for positioning and control of boat handling lines.
