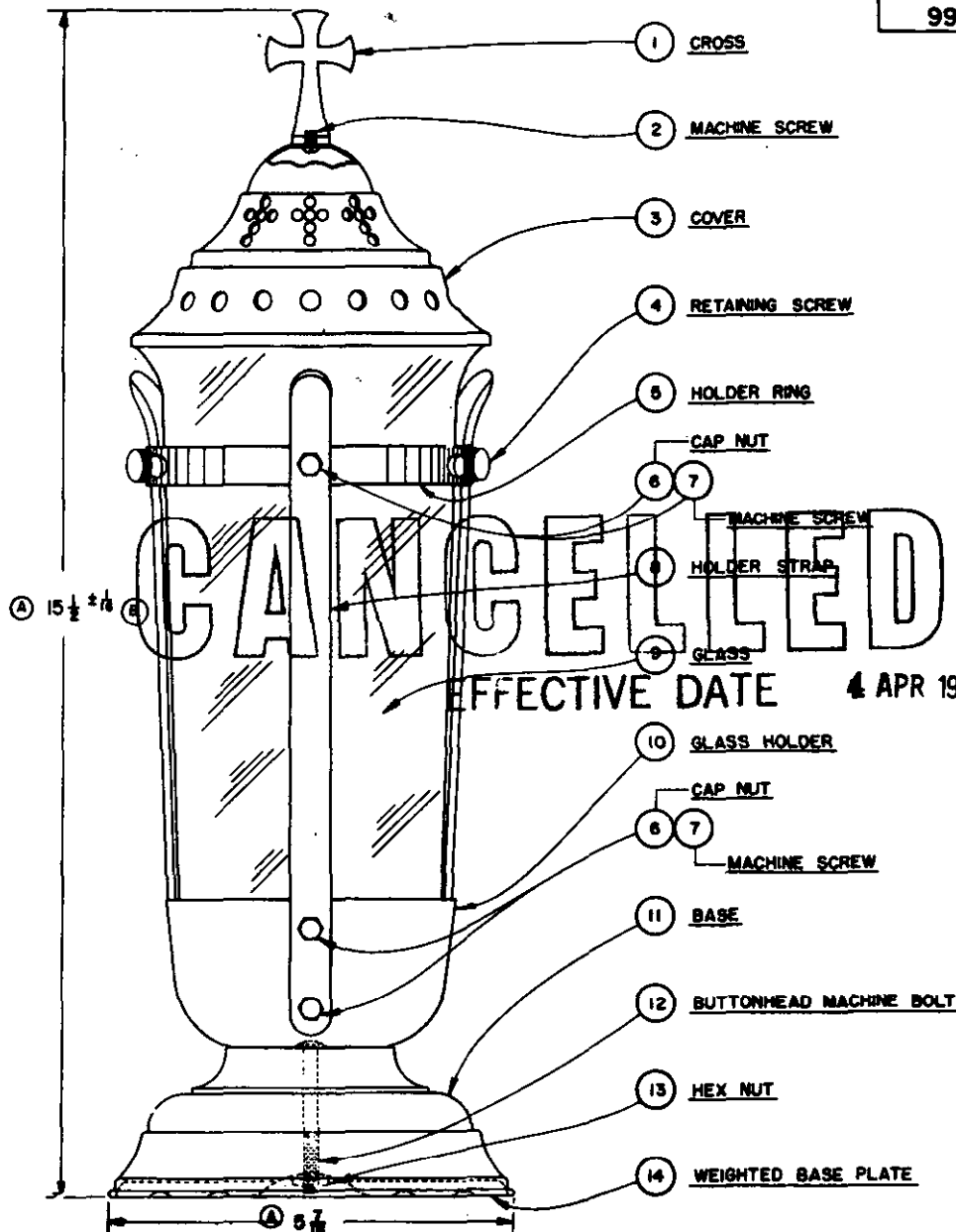

- ③ MATERIAL: All metal parts shall be commercial yellow brass except the lead in the weighted base plate, piece 14. The glass shall be commercial ruby glass.
- ④ FINISH 1: All metal parts shall be highly polished except the holder straps, piece number 8, which shall have a compound satin finish. All metal parts shall be gold lacquered. (Finish 1 shall be used unless finish 2 is required by the contract or order.)
- ⑤ FINISH 2: When specified, finish shall be as follows: Electrodeposit copper to a minimum thickness of 0.0003 inch. Electrodeposit thereon nickel to a minimum thickness of 0.0005 inch. Buff parts moderately after application of nickel; then electrodeposit chromium to a minimum thickness of 0.00005 inch.
- ⑥ TOLERANCES: Unless otherwise specified: Fractions $\pm 1/64$ inch, Decimals ± 0.005 inch.
