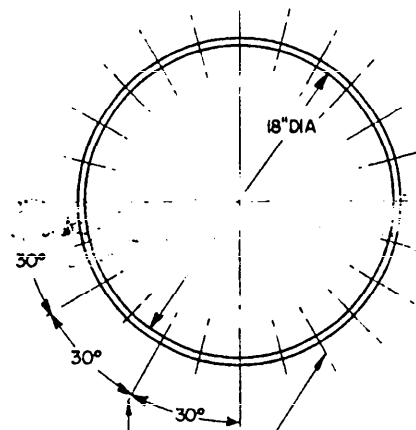


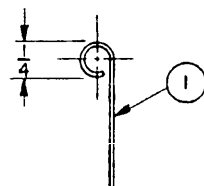

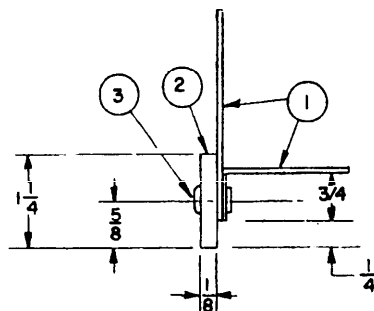


HOLES STAGGERED ON CENTERS SPACED THUS

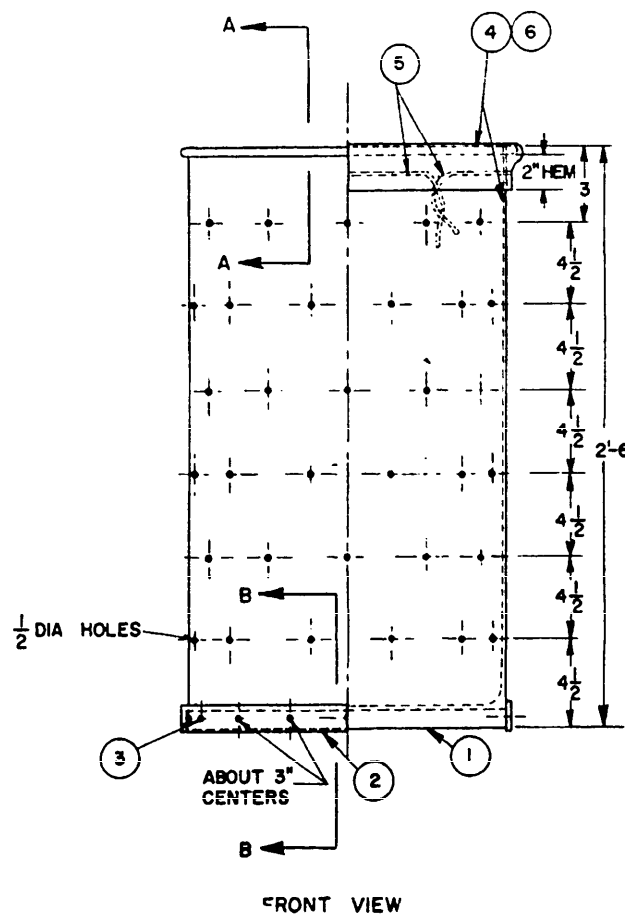
TOP VIEW

NOTES:

- The hamper shall be finished in white baked enamel.
- The top of the hamper shall be finished with a 1/4 inch rolled edge.
- The length of the bag shall be 32 inches and shall be fitted with 36 brass grommets in three alternating rows, commencing with the bottom row. The grommets shall be spaced to match the corresponding rows of holes in the hamper.
- Cotton thread shall be used in accordance with type III of Specification V-T-276; upper thread should be 8/4 and lower thread 10/4.
- Bag shall be secured in the hamper by turning the top of the bag down about 2 inches over the rim of the hamper.
- The height of the bag shall be 32 inches when finished with a 2 inch wide hem. Two grommets spaced 2-1/2 inches to 3 inches apart shall be inserted in the inside of the hem to take the free ends of the drawstring. Diametrically opposite the grommets, the drawstring shall be secured in a manner that will prevent the drawstring from being pulled out of the hem.
- This standard takes precedence over documents referenced herein.
- Referenced specifications shall be the issue in effect on date of invitation for bids.
