

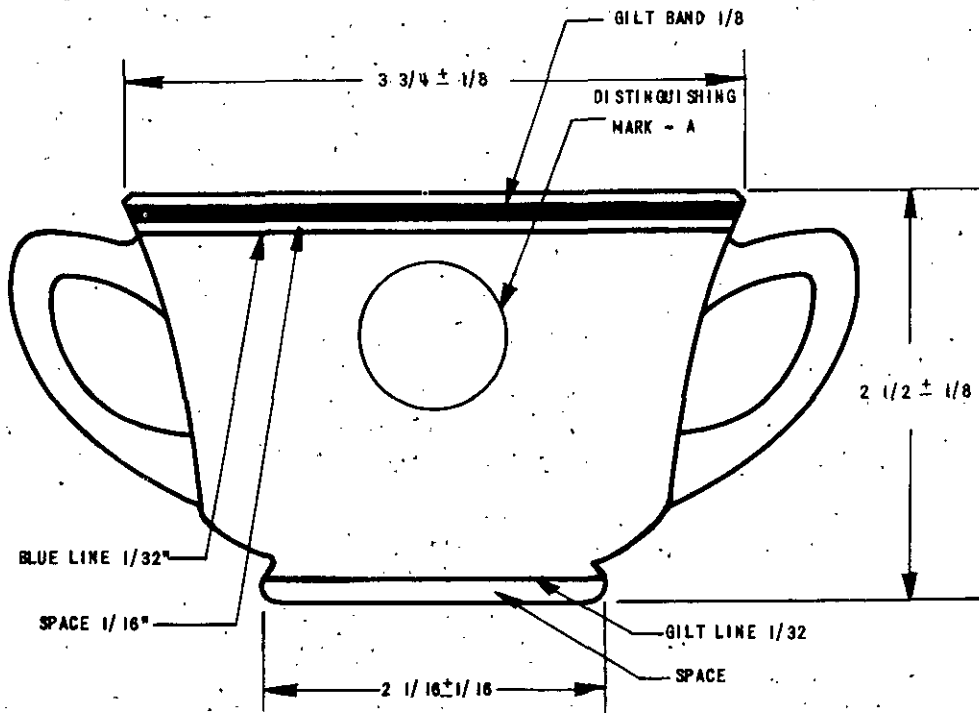

4. MARKINGS - EXCEPT FOR THE BLUE LINE, ALL OTHER DECORATIONS, INCLUDING THE DISTINGUISHING MARK, SHALL BE IN COIN GOLD OVER GLAZE.
5. FOR DISTINGUISHING MARK REFER STANDARD MS. 16916.
