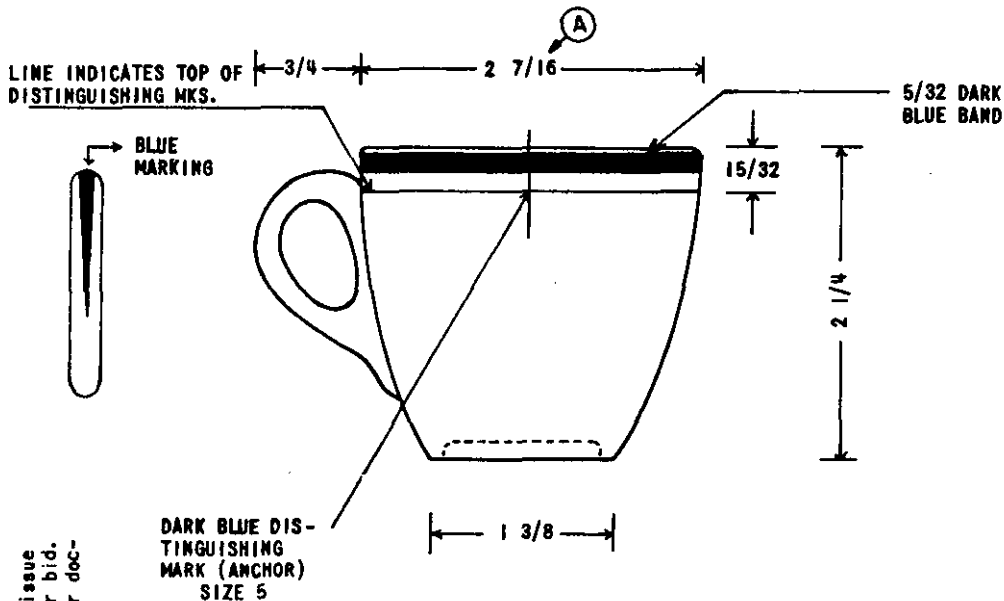


This standard has been approved by the Department of the NAVY and is mandatory for use by that activity. All other military activities are required to employ this standard where suitable.
