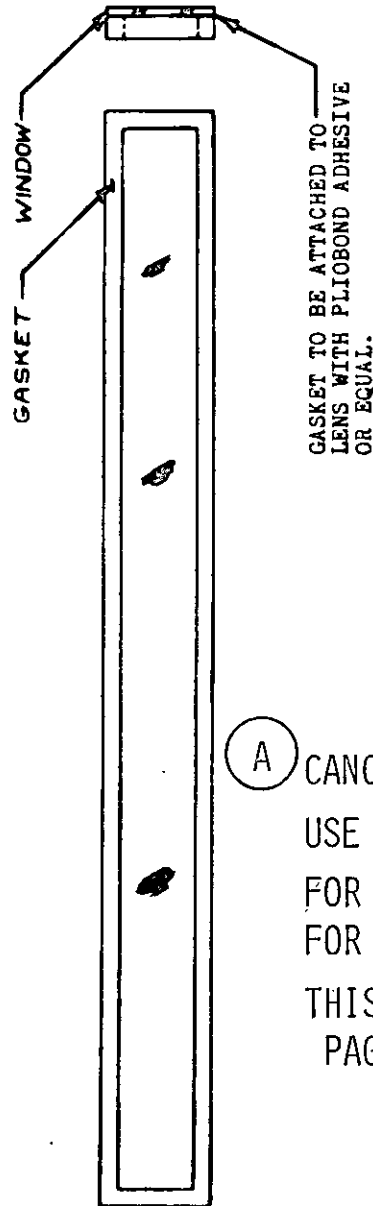


## BUREAU OF SHIPS
