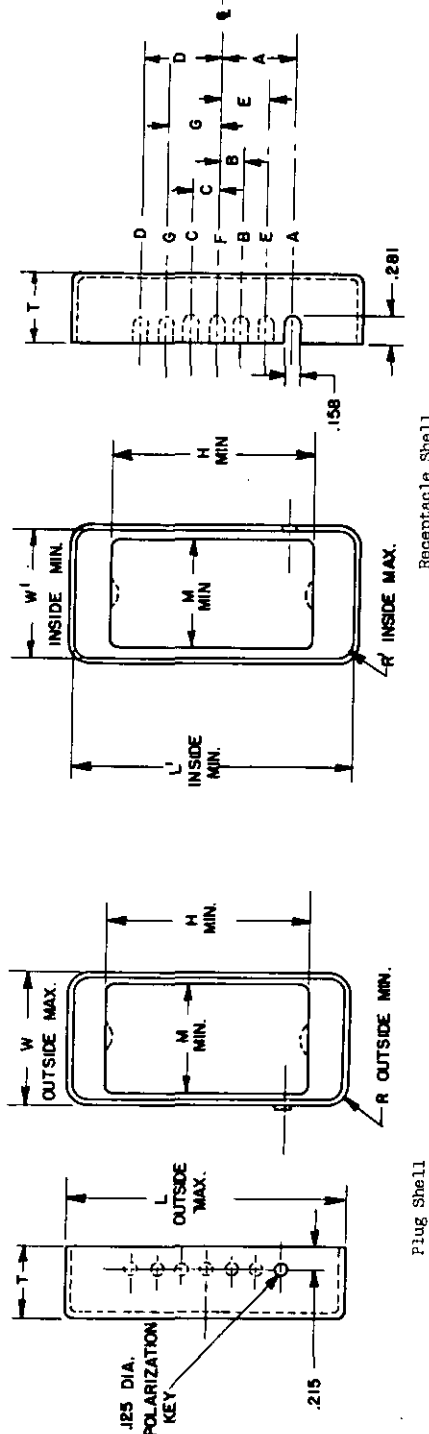


This standard has been approved by the Bureau of Ships Department of the Navy, and is mandatory for use by their activity. All other military activities are required to employ this standard where suitable.
