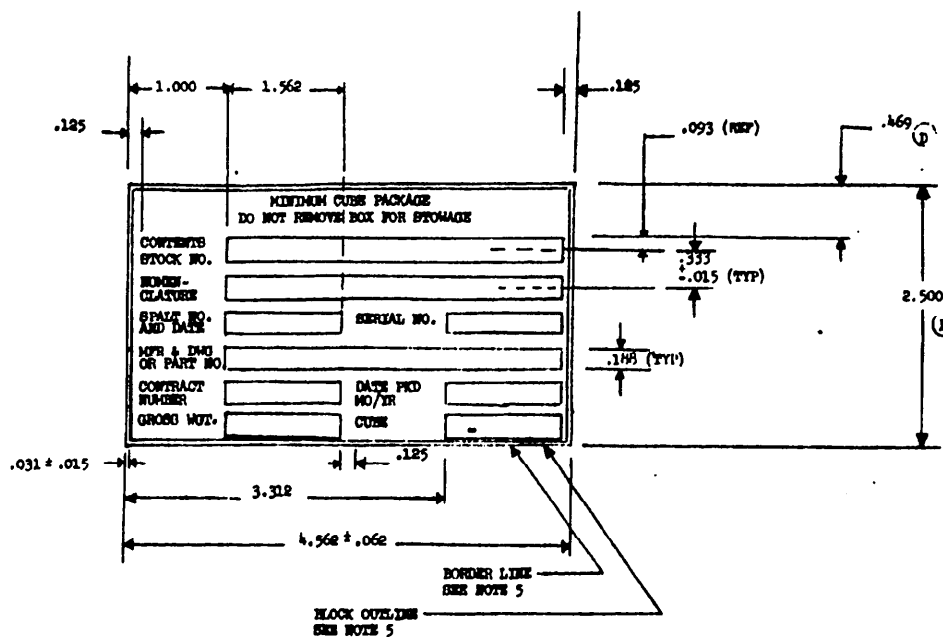

NOTES:

1. LABEL SHALL BE WHITE WITH BLACK PRINTING.
2. UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, ALL LETTERING SHALL BE .062 HIGH, WITH ARRANGEMENT APPROXIMATELY AS SHOWN.
3. LETTERS SHALL BE PLAIN GOTHIC STYLE.
4. SURFACE OF LABEL SHALL BE SUITABLE FOR TYPEWRITING OR HAND LETTERING WITH BLACK PENCIL OR INK.
5. BORDER LINE AND BLACK OUTLINES SHALL BE APPROXIMATELY .015 WIDE.
6. MATERIAL. LABELS WITH PRESSURE SENSITIVE BACKING SHALL CONFORM TO UU-L-49, TYPE II, STYLE I. SMOOTH FINISH WHITE PAPER CONTAINING NOT MORE THAN 15 PERCENT UNBLEACHED OR GROUND WOOD PULP SHALL BE USED.
7. DIMENSIONS IN INCHES. UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, TOLERANCES: DECIMALS = .031 AND ALL TOLERANCES NON-CUMULATIVE. DIMENSIONING & TOLERANCING SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH MIL-STD-8.

FOR DESIGN FEATURE PURPOSES, THIS STANDARD TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER PROCUREMENT DOCUMENTS REFERENCED HEREIN. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE OF THE ISSUE IN EFFECT ON DATE OF INVITATIONS FOR BID.
