The requirements for acquiring the product described herein shall consist of this specification sheet and MIL-R-81729.





FIGURE 1. Belt assembly.

FIGURE 2. Left side of belt.

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


FIGURE 3. View B-B.




FIGURE 4. View A-A.





FIGURE 5. Right side of belt (for dimensions not shown, see figure 2).

NOTES:

1. Material:

- a. Webbing, nylon, MIL-W-27265, sage green.
- b. Pull tab, nylon, PIA-W-4088, type II, class 1, or PIA-T-5038, type IV, sage green.
- c. Pocket, nylon, PIA-T-5038, type II, sage green.
- d. Thread, nylon, V-T-295, type I, # 6 cord, sage green.
- e. Thread, nylon, V-T-295, type I, size E, sage green.

2. Finish: Material dyed sage green shall be a visual match to FED-STD-595, sage green, # 34158 or 34159. All stitching shall be in accordance with ASTM-D6193, type 301, and be not less than 4 nor greater than 6 stitches per inch except as noted. Ends of stitching shall be backstitched a distance of not less than ½ inch. Stitching shall be with nylon thread, # 6 cord except as noted.

3. Unless otherwise specified, dimensions shall be in inches. Tolerance: decimals  $\pm .06$ .

4. Referenced documents shall be of the issue in effect on the date of invitation for bid or request for proposal.

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5. For design feature purposes, this specification sheet takes precedence over procurement documents referenced herein.
6. The margins of this specification are marked with vertical lines to indicate where changes from previous issue were made. This was done as a convenience only and the Government assumes no liability whatsoever for any inaccuracies in these notations. Bidders and contractors are cautioned to evaluate the requirements of this document based on the entire content irrespective of the marginal notations and relationship to the last previous issue.
