(F) REQUIREMENTS:

1. TYPE II, CLASS 3 OF PROCUREMENT SPECIFICATION (OIL FILTER ELEMENT). SAME AS SHOWN IN FIG. 2, NOTE 2 OF NATO STANAG 4016.
2. SEALS OR GROMMETS TO BE SECURED TO EACH END OF ELEMENT AND TO BE CAPABLE OF PROVIDING A SUITABLE SEAL AROUND 9/16 O.D. CENTER TUBE.
3. PULL OUT DEVICE MUST NOT EXCEED THESE DIMENSIONS, INSTALLED.
4. MARKING SHALL CONSIST OF THE MS PART NUMBER AND MANUFACTURER'S IDENTIFICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH MIL-STD-130.

1. DIMENSIONS ARE IN INCHES.
2. FOR DESIGN FEATURE PURPOSES, THIS STANDARD TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER PROCUREMENT DOCUMENTS REFERENCED HEREIN.
3. THIS STANDARD IS NOT INTENDED TO LIMIT CONSTRUCTION TO FEATURES OTHER THAN AS SHOWN HEREON BY DIMENSION, NOTATIONS, AND REFERENCED DOCUMENTS.
4. REFERENCED DOCUMENTS SHALL BE OF THE ISSUE IN EFFECT ON DATE OF INVITATION FOR BIDS.
