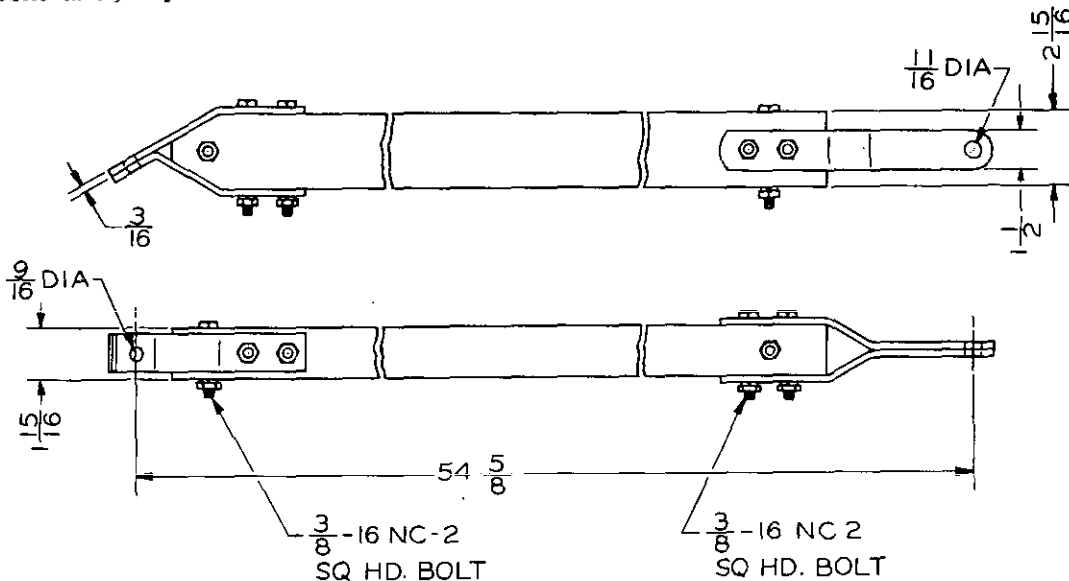

6. ALL SCREW THREADS SHALL BE UNC-2 PER NATIONAL BUREAU OF STANDARDS PUBLICATION H-28. THREADS OF NUTS SHALL NOT BE GALVANIZED.
