



GENERAL: THE M428A1 IS A 4 DUAL WHEEL VAN TYPE TRAILER USED IN THE NIKE HERCULES SYSTEM FOR ACCOMODATING MISSILE-TRACKING AND TARGET-TRACKING RADAR EQUIPMENT. THE BODY IS INSULATED WITH BONDED HONEY-COMB TYPE INSULATION AND PROVIDED WITH HEATING AND VENTILATING DUCTS. THE TRAILER IS PROVIDED WITH FOUR CORNER TIE-DOWNS, FOUR FRAME TIE-DOWNS, FOUR LIFTING EYES, WHEEL CHOCKS, REAR PLATFORM, REAR BUMPER, AND A GROUND ROD STUD. IT HAS A PIVOTING FRONT DOLLY APPROX. 85° EACH DIRECTION FROM CENTER AND A FIXED REAR DOLLY WHICH ARE DETACHABLE FROM THE TRAILER BED. THE FRONT DOLLY CONSISTS OF A CONESHAPE FIFTH WHEEL ASSEMBLY AND INCLUDES INDEPENDENT WHEEL SUSPENSION, DETACHABLE INTERVEHICULAR CABLE, AND SAFETY CHAINS. THE REAR DOLLY IS AN 'A' FRAME TYPE THAT INCLUDES STABILIZER BAR, SWAYBAR, SERVICE AND HAND BRAKE. THE TRAILER INTERIOR IS EQUIPPED WITH FLUORESCENT AND INCANDESCENT LIGHT FIXTURES WHICH SERVE AS OPERATIONAL, EMERGENCY, AND BLACKOUT LIGHTS.
