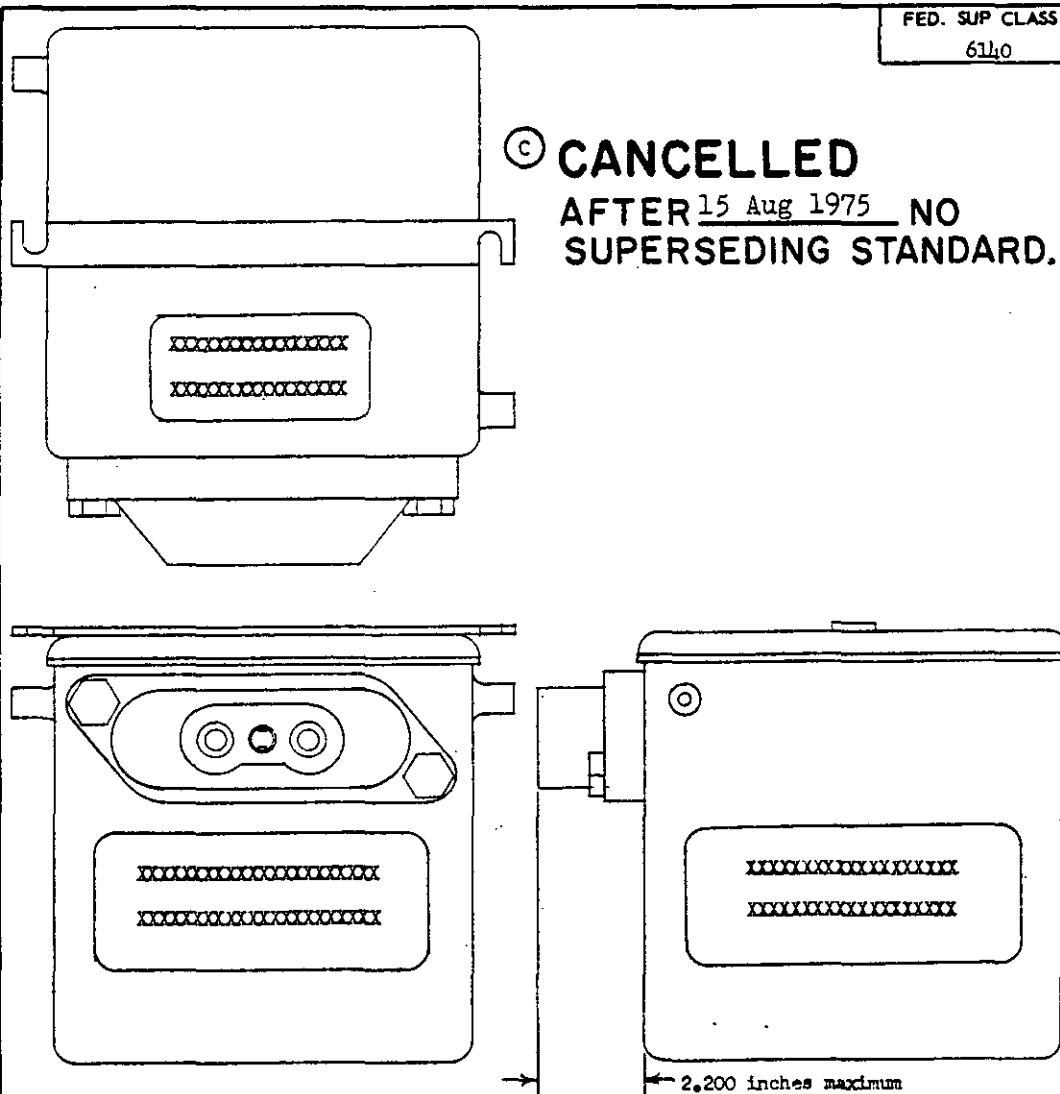

NOTES:

1. MS PART NUMBERS - The MS part numbers of the batteries shall be as listed above.
2. DESIGN STANDARD - Each battery shall conform to MS18093 for size number 2 except as shown otherwise above.
3. NOMINAL CAPACITY - The nominal capacity of each battery shall be 10 ampere-hours.
4. MAXIMUM WEIGHT - The weight of each battery filled with electrolyte shall not exceed the value listed above in any state of charge.
5. SPECIFICATION - The batteries shall conform to requirements of MIL-B-8565 for general purpose, maintainable, ventilated, receptacle-connected, limited attitude, cradle-mounted, hook-held, medium duty batteries.
6. INACTIVE FOR DESIGN - These batteries are inactive for design - no new aircraft shall be designed to use either of them, nor shall any existing aircraft be modified to use either of them.

This standard has been approved by the Naval Air Systems Command, Department of the Navy, and is mandatory for use by that activity. All other military activities are required to comply with this standard where suitable.
